Rotary Foundation The Many Ways We Can Give

There are a variety of ways Rotary club members can contribute to the worthy goals of the Rotary Foundation that go beyond annual giving programs.

For instance, the Foundation's Group Study Exchange is encouraged by and largely funded through the Foundation in its effort to promote world peace and understanding. Another fine program PolioPlus, which has virtually eradicated the disease worldwide.

There is also the Ambassadorial Scholarships, one of the jewels of the Foundation. Founded in 1947, this scholarship is the Foundation's oldest and best-known program. More than 40,000 men and women from nearly 100 nations have studied abroad under its auspices.

Today it is one of the world's largest privately funded international scholarships programs. Seven hundred scholarships were awarded for study last year alone. Through grants totaling approximately \$16.2 million, recipients from 70 countries studied in more than 80 nations.

The purpose of the Ambassadorial Scholarships program is to further international understanding and friendly relations among people of different countries and geographical areas. While abroad, scholars serve as goodwill ambassadors to the host country and give presentations about their homelands to Rotary clubs and other groups. Upon returning home, scholars share with Rotarians and others the experiences that

led to a greater understanding of their host country.

It is through our dues and individual contributions, along with commitments from the worlds Rotary clubs, that programs such as this one is made possible.

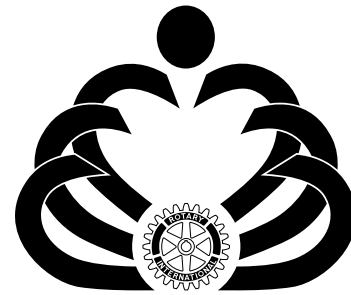
